Each year the Academic Development Centre (ADC) collaborates with MRU departments and programs by working with faculty members to support elearning and major curriculum design/redesign projects. The ADC is currently accepting applications for projects for the 2020/21 academic year.

Curriculum Support Projects

The ADC is available to support major curriculum design or redesign projects. Specific activities undertaken as part of these projects may include:

- Exploration of current and future aspects of the course/program (needs assessment)
- Curricular mapping to examine the alignment of outcomes, learning activities, and assessment at a course or program level
- Analysis of opportunities for integration of high-impact learning experiences and design of such curricula
- For new courses, articulation of course learning outcomes and exploration of pedagogies and assessment methods aligned with those outcomes

Successful applicants will collaborate with ADC faculty development consultants and professional staff, as appropriate, on the design/redesign process. Participants will have opportunity to engage in an action research cycle to assess the initial and continuing success of curricular changes.

eLearning Projects

The ADC's eLearning team is available to support faculty in the development and maintenance of fully online and blended courses, including the "flipped classroom" approach. Faculty members work in a team environment as subject matter experts with an instructional design consultant, graphic designer, videographer and other ADC staff and faculty, as required. Through the development of eLearning projects, we hope to expand access to learning opportunities, increase flexibility for students, and enhance student learning outcomes.
